On October 24, 1981, Susan met JAMES R. BISHOP at the Westview Club on Valley Hills Drive, as introduced by Susan's friend, Rachel Deskins.

James stated he had just gotten back from Germany and was at the present time separated from his wife.

James started dating Susan about every day after Christmas. They would see each other after work at Susan's mother's house at 3211 N. 18th. or at the Westview Club, Broken Promise Club or at Charlie's Corner.

UBERISH:

James is described as very quiet until he gets to know the person. James did not talk much about himself or his home life. Did work at Maco Billiard Center then started working at Charlie's also. Susan said that no matter how late they stayed up the night before, James would go to work the next day.

James supposedly got into a fight at Charlies Corner over a pool game. Police Department was not notified.

James did state he was a narcotic officer in the Army and had gotten shot during a raid.

James left Maco in April 1981 and came back in late July, after the murders.

When Susan came back, James appeared to have changed in appearance, dress and manners. James did not talk much to Susan until late one night, possibly July 27th. or 28th., when they stayed out. James said he had a fight with his father and was moving out. He was very

James sexual habits were that Susan had to start the foreplay to get James started, he would never get a full erection. Susan felt at times that James might have homosexual tendencies.

PARENTAL RELATIONS:

Even though James respected his father, they would get into arguments frequently. James appeared to be close to his mother, Betty, but did not have any respect for her. In January or February of 1982, his attitude changed toward his mother. Betty would walk up to James in public or at home and grasp James's penis through his clothes.

Susan stated that Betty Bishop was an alcoholic. James was very close to his sister, Cathy Bishop Puente.

James had become upset recently finding out that Russell Bishop was not his natural father, this was prior to his leaving Maco, between April and July.

COURTANCES:

James knew a mexican by nickname of ROOSTER or RED, could be Gilbert Melendez. Knew David [unclear], from coming in the pool hall on 25th. Street.
