18. Narrative: The above was reported to the dispatcher as a structure fire. I proceeded to the location from Chapparral Rd. I observed heavy black smoke from a distance from the fire. As I turned onto Angel Fire from Sierra Slope, I heard one explosion.

I observed two or possibly three men pulling water hoses from the front yard to the back of the house where a storage shed was fully involved in flames.

I asked one male subject, now known as Ed Graf, Jr., if anyone was inside the house. He replied, "No". These subjects proceeded to spray water on the building with the water hoses. The Fire Department arrived, at which time I spoke to Ed Graf again.

He, at this time told me that he could not locate his two boys. I asked him if they had bicycles they rode and if they were there. The bicycles were on the patio.

A quick search of the street, asking neighborhood children if they had seen the two boys, was made. All of the children indicated that they had not seen the two boys.

Mr. Graf then told me that they had arrived home before 5:00 PM and he told the boys to change clothes before they went outside to play.

He told me that Joby was wearing a red shirt, but he didn't know what Jason was wearing.

I asked Mr. Graf if he keeps the building locked. He said he did not lock the building but did keep the door pushed shut. He said when he noticed the fire the door was open.

I notified the Fire Personnel that two boys from the (cont'd)

Mr. Graf said the building was used to store lawn mowers, paint, and did have a can of gasoline inside.

After the fire was extinguished, only portions of the studs from the walls were left.

The tin roof had been pulled away by the Fire Department Personnel.

Fire Department Personnel told me that a body had been located. The body was lying on it's back and was toward the rear portion of the building.

Chaplain Creppon was contacted to be with the family. Also Judge John Cabaniss was contacted and came to the scene. After the Judge arrived the first body was removed by Fire Department Personnel and Connally Compton Funeral Home. The other body was located, also at the rear of the building, under debris.

At this time there is no indication as to how the fire started. The door area of the building was extremely charred.

The victim's names and ages are:

Jason Cory Graf, W/M, age 8, D.O.B. 01-31-78.

Joby Allen Graf, W/M, age 9, D.O.B. 09-24-77.

The building has no electricity connected to it. A gas can was observed just inside the doorway.

It was learned that the boys had earlier been playing with a T.S. Clinch, 512 Angel Fire, and Terry Wills of 808 Sierra Slope. These two were contacted by Detectives Latham and Colwell. Both stated they had not been in contact with the boys except earlier in the afternoon.

An autopsy has been ordered by Judge Cabaniss. Photos and videos taken by Detectives.
