Cellmate Implicates Spence

WACO (AP) — A former McLennan County Jail inmate testified Friday that capital murder defendant David Wayne Spence told him "there was some money" involved in the 1982 killings of three teen-agers near Lake Waco.

Jerry Jennings, 30, told a state district court jury that he and Spence were confined together last September. Jennings, who said he was recently paroled on a robbery conviction, said Spence asked him if he knew about "the park killings."

Jennings said Spence later told him that "there was some money" involved in the slayings.

"He said if he would have got the money, he would have left the state and never come back," Jennings said.
