DA Grievance Hearing Reported Underway

McLennan County District Attorney Vic Feazell and his attorney Gary Richardson of Tulsa, Oklahoma were seen entering the Texas National Bank Office building at 3:45 p.m. Thursday afternoon where sources say a meeting of the Waco-McLennan County Bar Association grievance committee is reported to be hearing a number of grievances filed against the local DA.

with the latest failure coming in May. Scott was accompanied by another man but it is not known what his position is in the hearings.

A court reporter was also seen entering the building, meaning the proceedings will probably be recorded.

Waco Attorney Larry Brady, chairman of the grievance committee, has made no statements concerning the hearings.

Feazell was acquitted in June of racketeering charges brought by the federal government. An Austin jury found him not guilty after his indictment by a federal grand jury in 1986.

Grievance committee meetings are held in secret and no reports are made following the meetings.

The hearing reportedly was called for July 23 and cancelled when Richardson could not appear with Feazell and reset for 4 p.m. Thursday.

Also seen entering the building was David Scott, an employee of the DA's office, who represented himself as a Texas lawyer, when it was discovered he did not have a Texas Law License. Scott has reportedly failed the Texas Bar exam four times,
