MR. WALSH: Certainly. 1 MR. PARKER: Then we can make whatever 2 objections that need to be made at that time. I 3 think we've got it preserved. 4 THE COURT: Well, this will give you the 5 guideline to get this done, Mr. Walsh. I'll give 6 this --7 MR. WALSH: I've got it marked, Judge. I 8 understand. 9 THE COURT: Then I'll give it to the 10 Court Reporter. 11 Now, is there anything else? 12 MR. PARKER: Not at this time. 13 THE COURT: You'll raise your objections 14 in the morning. 15 MR. PARKER: Yes. 16 THE COURT: All right. Here is the tape. 17 Anything else? 18 MR. PARKER: Not at this time. 19 THE COURT: All right. Court stands in 20 recess until 9:00 o'clock tomorrow morning. 21 22 (Whereupon the hearing was 23 recessed, to reconvene at 9:00 24 a.m., April 5, 1985.) 25
