## Fezell's office full after 10 months

For the first time in the 10 months District Attorney Vic Fezell has been in office, Fezell's legal staff is up to capacity of 12 attorneys. The office, however, is losing an investigator.

Angel deJesus Gavito was introduced to McLennan County commissioners Monday as a new misdemeanor prosecutor.

Gavito, 32, who was born in Mexico, is a graduate of the Baylor University law school and the University of Texas at El Paso. He worked as a law clerk for Waco attorney Whitney Fanning before attending law school.

During the last three months, he has worked as an attorney in Fanning's office.

Meanwhile, Allen Lewis, an investigator with the district attorney's office for five years, has resigned, effective Oct. 31, to become an investigator with the Texas Department of Human Resources in Waco.
