Grand Jury Hearing Police Case

Allen Levy, Special prosecutor appointed by District Attorney Vic Feazell, began, presenting information to the July, 1985 term of the grand jury Monday in regards to the police shooting of Michael Wayne Royals on March 12, 1985.

Sgt. Dean Priddy reportedly accidentally shot Royals following his capture after a high speed chase through the city of Waco. The shooting occurred near the TSTI Campus.

Royals spent several days in the hospital for treatment of a gunshot wound in the stomach.

Several law enforcement officers were waiting including Waco Police

Chief Larry Scott, to be heard by the grand jury.

Foreman is C. W. Barrett.
