

ROSALIND HAMMOND INTERVIEW-HAMMOND'S GROCERY-700 DAY
AVE, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA -NOVEMBER 17, 1993

I met Ms. Hammond in front of her grocery store, and we spoke there. She started by asking me if I had a picture of the man I thought she may be able to identify. I pulled out the picture and turned on the recorder at this point.

BS: Was this the man?

RH: Yep.

BS: And it was on...

RH: That side right there.

BS: This lot right here. Do you happen to know who owns those two lots?
