# Jury selection continues in television slander trial

WACO — Jury selection in the slander trial of a Dallas television station and its former reporter continues today in state district court here.

Attorneys for both sides interviewed potential jurors Monday, but none were selected.

Former McLennan County District Attorney Vic Feazell says a 1985 series of televised reports, linking him to kickbacks and suspicious bookkeeping practices, were inaccurate and intended to ruin his career.

Feazell beat a federal racketeer-

ing rap based on allegations similar to those that constituted the news reports. He contends in court documents that the reports and the federal investigation were instigated after he debunked the multiple confessions of convicted murderer Henry Lee Lucas.

Dallas' WFAA-TV and reporter Charles Duncan, in their court filings, contend the reports were accurate and were acceptable comment on a public official.

Feazell is asking for \$36 million in damages. The trial is expected to last a month.
