Marquez given formal sentence in district court

Adan Marquez Marquez, found guilty of murder Thursday in the Jan. 3 beating death of Frank (Pancho) Rodriguez, was formally sentenced to 15 years in the Texas Department of Corrections on Friday in Judge Raymond Mormino's 170th State District Court.

Defense attorneys John Segrest and Fernando Villarreal notified the court that Marquez began serving his sentence Jan. 3, which is when he was arrested.

Segrest also gave notice that he would appeal the jury's verdict.

In other court action this week:

- Louis Anthony Stewart, accused of murder in the death of a guard at a Waco Amvets post, was scheduled to go on trial July 30.
- Vicki Phillips Sharp was sentenced to 10 years' probation and ordered to pay a \$1,500 fine for possession of methamphetamines.
- Michael Charles Caswell was sentenced to four years' probation and ordered to pay a \$700 fine for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle.
- Maurice Cleveland Gross was given a six-year probated sentence and ordered to pay a \$1,200 fine for robbery.
- Eulogio Lopez received a five-year probated sentence and was ordered to pay a \$1,800 fine for burglary of a motor vehicle.
- Teresa Carol James was sentenced to three years on probation and ordered to pay a \$500 fine for possession of methamphetamines.
