NARRATIVE Lucas then said to call Montague County, Sheriff Conway 817-894-2871, which Ross did. Deputy Ross explained the situation to Sheriff Conway, Conway said he would call Deputy Ross back at Sheriff's office this date for further details on this subject. Deputy Ross also ran 10-28 and 10-29 on this subject, copies of which are attached to this report. In talking with Sheriff Conway he said that Katie P. Rich and Fredia L. Powell were reported missing for approximately 2 to 3 months. Sheriff Conway also said he had sent out APB for missing persons on Fredia L. Powell and Katie P. Rich, who were missing from Jacksonville, Florida, to Lering, El Paso, Las Cruces, and Dallas, Texas areas. Then Lucas explained that the reason he was bringing these two girls back was to prove to Sheriff Conway that the two were still alive and not missing, but they had got away from him. However, Sheriff Conway told Deputy Ross that Henry Lucas was wanted for murder back east, but gave no other details and said the information was confidential. At the same time Ruben Moore and his wife were also at the Red X. Moore said Lucas worked for him and he had come to pick him up. Henry Lucas said he had called Ruben Moore sometime prior to this incident to send him some money, which Moore did. He sent \$50.00 for Lucas to get back home on. Lucas had car trouble and made it necessary for him to again call Moore for help. Moore said he used to believe Lucas until Lucas changed stories so often. Moore said he was not sure of Lucas's story this time. Ruben Moore then told Deputy Ross to take care of the car by having it towed to a garage. Moore said the car belonged to a relative of his and that Lucas was buying it, but had not paid in full yet. The car was registered to Martha Walker of Bowie, Texas, License tag number UWX-484, VIN/2L57R3X184487 2 dr Catalina Pontiac, maroon in color. Moore then gave Deputy Ross his telephone number
