Physician found dead

Dr. Anthony J. Quinn, 44, a physician who practiced at the Lake Shore Women's Clinic, was found dead of a "self-inflicted gunshot wound" Tuesday morning at his residence, said Justice of the Peace Joe Johnson.



Johnson said Quinn shot himself once in the head with a .38-caliber revolver that was purchased on Saturday.

Waco Police spokesman Bud Thurman said a maid found a note on the door of Quinn's residence, 2808 Chimney Hill Drive, Tuesday morning. The note instructed her to call the police before entering the house. Police were summoned around 9 a.m. and found Quinn dead in his garage area.

Police said Quinn died between 5 p.m. Monday and 9 a.m. Tuesday.

Thurman said he did not believe Quinn's note gave any reason for a suicide.

Quinn, who was divorced several years ago, had suffered from depression for several months and had undergone treatment, Johnson said.
