

VOLUNTARY STATEMENT
(NOT UNDER ARREST)

I, WALTER S. SMITH, am not under arrest for, nor am I being detained for any criminal offenses concerning the events I am about to make known to FRANK LYNNAM. Without being accused of or questioned about any criminal offenses regarding the facts I am about to state, I volunteer the following information of my own free will, for whatever purposes it may serve.

I am 44 years of age, and I live at 615 ANGEL FIRE, HEWITT TX.
ON AUGUST 26 - 1988 AT APPROX. 4:50 PM
WHILE DRIVING HOME FROM WORK, AT THE
CROSSING OF SPRING VALLEY & OLD TEMPLE RD
I SPOTTED A LARGE PUFF OF SMOKE AHEAD
& TO MY RIGHT. AS I GOT CLOSER I
REALIZED IT WAS COMMING FROM WITHIN
MY SUB-DIVISION, TURNING OFF SPRING
VALLEY ONE STREET EARLIER THAN NORMAL.
I PROCEEDED TO THE FIRE. I SAW A MAN
IN THE YARD BEHIND THE FIRE WITH A RADIO.
I VERIFIED THAT HE HAD CALLED FIRE DEPT. &
WENT TO FRONT OF 505 ANGEL FIRE, THE LOCATION
OF FIRE. SHED WAS FULLY INVOLVED IN FIRE
& REAR THIRD OF FOWLS WAS ON FIRE. (BETWEEN
HOMES) I KNOCKED ON THE DOOR OF 505 AND THE
MALE OCCUPANT ASKED WHAT I WANTED. I
TOLD HIM ^{WS} ABOUT THE FIRE AND SUGGESTED THAT
HE LEAVE THE HOUSE. HE STATED HE WAS SICK
CALLING THE FIRE DEPT. & I TOLD HIM THAT
WERE ON THE WAY.

THE MAN THEN SAID HE HAD TO FINISH CARRYING
BABY AND WOULD BE OUT 15 MINUTES.
I THEN HELPED OTHER PEOPLE HOKE UP WATER
HOSES FROM THE TWO HOUSES AND HANDED THEM
OVER THE FRONT FENCE TO HELP FIGHT FIRE
ON THE SIDE FENCE. A FEW MINUTES LATER A
FEW MEN KNOCKED THE FENCE DOWN TO
ALLOW THE APPROACHING FIREMAN ACCESS TO
THE FIRE. THE MAN FROM 505 SAW FIRE
COMING OUT FRONT DOOR SO CAME OUT &
ASKED WHY FIREMEN COULD NOT USE DRIVE
WAY GATE ON OTHER SIDE OF HOUSE.
AFTER A SHORT EXCHANGE OF WORDS HE WENT
BACK IN THE HOUSE. JUST BEFORE THIS
HAPPENED THE FIRE BECAME HOT ENOUGH TO
BURN THROUGH POWER LINES TO HOUSE
WITH POLICE ON SCENE & F.D. ARRIVED.
I WENT HOME, ONCE WATCHING ^{WS} T.V.
DURING SUPPER I HEARD ABOUT THE DEATHS
& TOLD MY WIFE "HE NEVER ONCE ASKED
WHY HIS KIDS WORK OR ASKED IF ANYONE
HAD BEEN KILLED."
