### Testimony ends in Feazell trial

AUSTIN — Testimony ended today in the 21-day-old federal bribery trial of McClennan County District Attorney Vic Feazell, accused of taking money from defense lawyers in order to settle criminal cases.

Final arguments will be heard Friday morning before the case goes to the jury of seven men and five women.

Feazell, 36, was tried on a 10-count racketeering indictment accusing him of bribery and mail fraud. He was specifically accused of taking about \$19,000 in bribes from attorneys in exchange for dismissing or reducing charges paneled by his office.
