THE STATE OF TEXAS VS. HENRY LEE LUCAS

CHARGE: UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A FIREARM BY A FELON

IN THE NAME AND BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

THE GRAND JURORS, for the County of Montague, State of Texas, duly selected, empaneled, sworn, charged, and organized as such at the June Term, 1983, of the 97th Judicial District Court for said County, upon their oaths present in and to said court at said term that HENRY LEE LUCAS, hereinafter styled Defendant, on or about the 4th day of June, 1983, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, did then and there intentionally and knowingly possess a firearm, to-wit: a handgun, away from the premises where he lived; and prior to the commission of said act, the said Henry Lee Lucas was duly and legally convicted of the felony offense of Murder, being a felony involving an act of violence to a person, to-wit: on the 23rd day of March, 1980, in the 39th Judicial District Circuit Court of Lenawee County, Michigan, in a case on the docket of said Court, Number 7359, and entitled The State of Michigan vs. Henry Lee Lucas, the said Henry Lee Lucas was duly and legally convicted of a felony offense of Murder, of which said offense said Court had jurisdiction, and which conviction occurred and the judgment thereon became final prior to the commission by the said Henry Lee Lucas, of the act hereinbefore charged against him.
