I ran in the house to call the fire department. My Aime informed me she just heard the news on the scanner, then she walked down to the house in question, the fire department was not there yet, but from over the fence you could see flames and lots of smoke. There weren't many people there at the time, and it looked like no one was home. Then a few minutes later the fire department arrived, they opened the fence I'm not sure how, and proceeded to put the fire out.
