ON AUG 26 AT APPROXIMATELY 5:00 PM,
I RESPONDED TO A FIRE PAGE FOR A POSSIBLE
STRUCTURE FIRE AT 505 ANGEL FIRE DRIVE IN
HEWITT, TX.

I ROLLED OUT ON THE SECOND TRUCK, 482.
WHEN WE ARRIVED, WE LEARNED THAT THE FIRE
WAS ISOLATED TO A STORAGE SHED LOCATED IN
THE REAR OF THE HOUSE, AND THAT THE FIRST
CREWS ON THE SCENE HAD THE FIRE UNDER
CONTROL.

ASST. FIRE CHIEF TOM LUCENAY INSTRUCTED
ME TO CONDUCT A NEIGHBORHOOD SEARCH FOR
TWO BOYS, NOW KNOWN AS JASON AND JOBY GAFT,
WHO WERE MISSING FROM THEIR RESIDENCE
AT 505 ANGEL FIRE.

I HAD GONE ABOUT TWO HOUSES DOWN THE STREET,
WHEN LUCENAY CALLED ME BACK AND INSTRUCTED
ME TO GUARD AND CONTROL THE FENCED-IN BACKYARD,
AND TO ALLOW NO ONE TO ENTER UNLESS THEY WERE
AUTHORIZED.

MR GAFT APPROACHED ME AT THE DRIVEWAY
GATE AND SAID HE HAD HEARD "SOMETHING" WAS
FOUND IN THE SHED AND THAT HE WAS CURIOUS
WHAT HAD BEEN FOUND. I TOLD MR. GAFT TO GO
INTO THE HOUSE AND SOMEONE WOULD BE IN
TO TALK TO HIM.

I THEN LOCKED THE DRIVEWAY GATE AND SEALED IT WITH CRIME SCENE TAPE AND WENT TO THE SIDE GATE ON THE NORTH END OF THE HOUSE AND ASSISTED OFFICER MOORE.

I LATER RETURNED WITH OTHER FIREMAN (SEE BELOW) TO CLEAN-UP THE SHED AND BACKYARD.
